## Healthy Tuck

From September, Bugle School will be adopting a 'Healthy Tuck' Policy, where children are only allowed to eat fruit and other healthy foods at playtime. This is widely adopted by most schools across the country, and research has shown that behaviour and concentration is better when children have eaten a healthy nutritious snack. However, we also understand the importance of children eating a balanced diet. Therefore, the children will be allowed one day (every Friday) where they can bring in something for their tuck as a 'treat'. These will still be monitored to ensure that children aren't over-eating too many unhealthy foods. Following the school council meeting this week the children have decided that they should bring in fruit or a healthy option of cereal bar for their tuck each day. The school tuck shop will have for sale crackers, dried fruit, hummus with carrot/peppers etc. On a Friday, as a treat the children will be able to bring a small chocolate bar or small bag of crisps into school. As this is a new change to school policy the adults will be monitoring and advising the children accordingly. I hope that you will support the school in making this positive change for children's health and wellbeing. Thank you.

**Is your child eligible for Free School Meals?** *Your child may be eligible for free school meals if you (or the child themselves in their own right) is in receipt of any of the following benefits.*

- Income Support (IS).
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190.
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC).
- Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support.

- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods.

## Universal Infant Free School Meals (UFSM)

All Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) pupils are entitled to receive a free school meal as part of the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UFSM) initiative, regardless of what benefits are being claimed.

If you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed above which would entitle your child to free school meals, your school could claim Pupil Premium funding to support your child's education, just by you completing an application form. When you apply we will check your eligibility for free school meals (or Pupil Premium for KS1 pupils) by checking against those held by HM Revenue and Customs, The Home Office and the Department of Work and Pensions.
