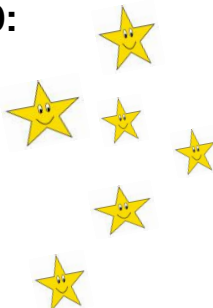

## ParentPay

Making a payment to the school is straightforward and ParentPay holds an electronic record of your payments to view later; no card details are stored in any part of the system and the school does not have access to this information.

Once you've activated your account you can make online payments straight away.



Parents who are unable to make payments online, or wish to continue paying in cash, can request a PayPoint Card. This will enable you to pay at any store which displays the PayPoint sign. Please be aware that payments made via PayPoint can take up to three days to be credited to pupil accounts.
