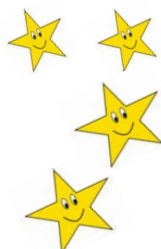

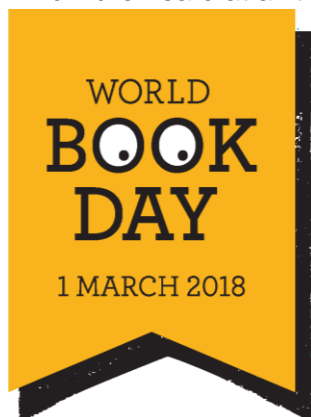

## Safer Internet Day 2018

On Tuesday, children from across all the year groups have been taking part in activities to raise their awareness of how to 'Create, Connect and Share Respect' on the internet. **Tuesday:**

### Pancake Recipe

**100g Plain Flour**

**2 Eggs**

**300ml Milk**

**1 tbsp sunflower or vegetable oil, plus a little extra for frying**

#### Method:

1. Put the flour, eggs, milk and a pinch of salt into a bowl or large jug, then whisk to a smooth batter. Set aside for 30 minutes to rest if you have time, or start cooking straight away.
2. Set a medium frying pan or crêpe pan over a medium heat and carefully wipe it with some oiled kitchen paper. When hot, cook your pancakes for 1 minute on each side until golden, keeping them warm in a low oven as you go.
3. Serve with lemon wedges and sugar, or your favourite filling.
