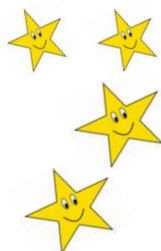

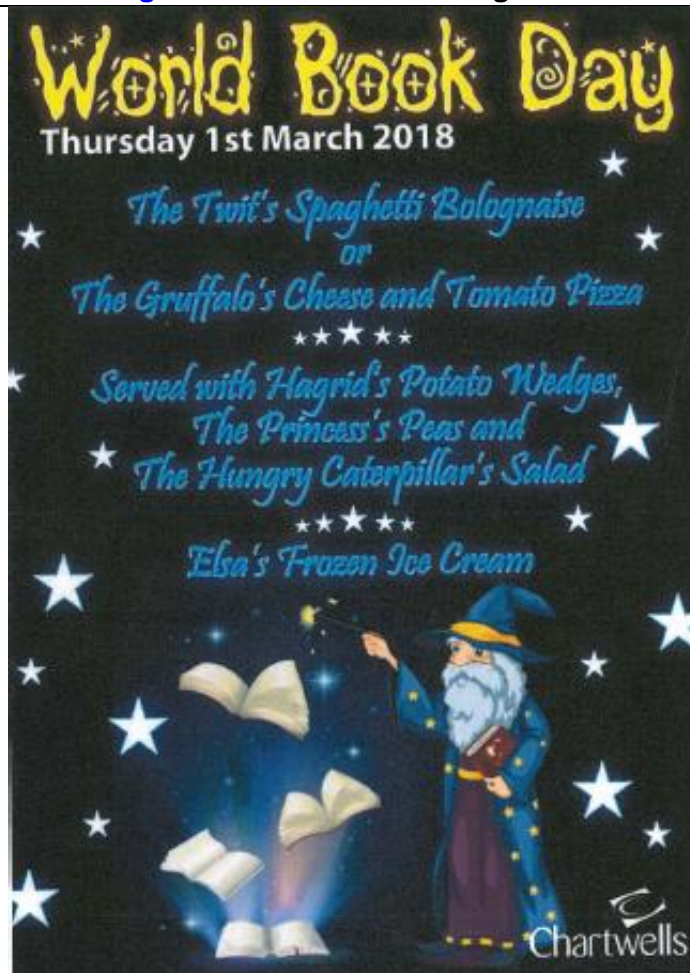
Attendance - Year 3

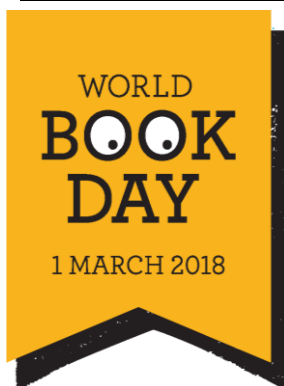
Jumble Sale
