On Tuesday 23rd June, we had a lady called Ross Birch visit us from Parliament. We had an assembly for KS2 children and she told us about parliament, how the Bill becomes the Law and what the House of Commons and House of Lords means. The House of Commons has politicians from all around the country. The House of Lords has experts (previous politicians).

A bill goes to the House of Commons first, the politicians vote, if there are over 50% votes for the Bill, it is fair to everyone, it goes to the House of Lords for them to debate the Bill.

If under 50% votes are received, the House of Commons has to debate the Bill again.

If the House of Lords vote under 50% the Bill goes back to the House of Commons and they debate it again.



If the Bill receives over 50% votes in the House of Lords, then it goes to the Queen for her to look at. If she agrees it, she stamps it and it becomes law, if she doesn't agree it then they stick with the old law.

Year 5 worked with Ross, we set up the House of Commons with benches in the school hall. We had a massive debate about starting homework in Year 9, rather than starting homework in primary school. We decided that it was better to start work in primary school rather than secondary (Year 9), as it helps us with practice for things like SATs tests.
