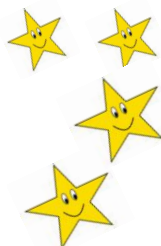

She can offer advice, or signpost the relevant agencies for issues such as:

- ⇒ Housing, debt, bereavement, Separation and Divorce, and Transport issues to school.
- ⇒ Behaviour concerns, sleep issues, dietary and wellbeing concerns.
- ⇒ Support for improving your child's attendance or behaviour.
- ⇒ Access to training, workshops, parenting courses.
- ⇒ Access to information.

32% of parents have yet to access their accounts, activation letters have been sent to you via satchel post.

ParentPay is an online payment system for schools. It allows parents to pay quickly and securely for school meals, trips and activities and fees.

You simply top-up your ParentPay account online by debit or credit card, or in cash

through PayPoint stores. Your ParentPay balance can be used immediately to pay for any of your children's items at any school using ParentPay.
