Dear Parents

To ensure the safety of pedestrians, please could you enter and exit the school using the top gate. The driveway should not be used by pedestrians to enter and exit the school.

A reminder that if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 they are entitled to receive a free school meal, under the government's new UIFSM scheme. Some children are unfortunately bringing in unhealthy packed lunches.

To help your child have a nutritious healthy lunch we suggest that a lunchbox include something from each of these groups every day:

Starchy food: eg wholegrain roll, tortilla wrap, chapatti, pitta pocket, bagels, breadsticks, pasta, cous cous or rice salad.

Protein: portion of lean meat, fish eg chicken, ham, beef, tuna, egg, beans or hummus.

Fruit and vegetables: Aim for at least 3 portions of fruit and vegetables during the school day, eg an apple, satsuma, handful of cherry tomatoes, carrot sticks, small tub of fruit salad or a small box of raisins.

Dairy products: A portion of semi-skimmed milk or other dairy product eg soft/hard cheese, yoghurt or fromage frais.

Healthy drink: eg fruit juice, yoghurt drink or bottle of water.

School Admissions Do you have a child who was born between 1st September 2010 and 31st August 2011?

If so, you must apply for a place in a reception class for that child by 15th January 2015, even if he/she already has an early years or nursery place at your preferred primary school.

Transfer to Secondary School - deadline for applications is 23:59 on 31st October 2014

The system will generate an immediate confirmation email that your application has been submitted successfully. You will receive your child's allocation details via email on the allocation date so you don't have to wait for the post.

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium Do You Qualify?

From September 2014, all KS1 children (Reception, Year 1 and 2) are eligible to receive free school meals. However, if you are in



receipt of one or more of the benefits listed below and do not receive Working Tax Credits, the school could benefit from Pupil Premium funding to support your child just by filling in an application form. Application forms are available from the school office.

To qualify you must be in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- ☐ Income Support
- ☐ Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance
- ☐ Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- ☐ Child Tax Credit with an annual income of no more than £16,190

- ☐ Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- ☐ Support under Part VI of Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

Please note, if you are in receipt of Working Tax Credit, you do not qualify for Free School Meals, even if your income is below £16,190.

If you are entitled to Free School Meals, but are not claiming them, forms can be obtained from the school office.
