## Roadworks.....

Cormac Solutions Limited will be undertaking civil engineering works at Bugle Crossroads. This will involve:

- Enhanced pedestrian provision at the signalised junction
- Improved street lighting
- Renewed puffin crossing
- Tidy up of signage

Work will take approximately 6 weeks, with 4 way temporary traffic lights replacing the permanent lights between 20<sup>th</sup> April and 22<sup>nd</sup> May. Some of the work may require the road being closed between 19:00 and 06:00 on weekday evenings.

Extra queuing traffic is to be expected on all four approaches to the crossroads. Motorists are advised to use alternative routes wherever possible to avoid delays. During this time, you are strongly advised to allow extra time for your journeys school, or if at all possible, please walk to and from school, to help ease traffic congestion. Thank you.
