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Home Learning Pack Contents

To develop Maths skills -

- Numicon shapes 1-10 these can be used teach your child maths skills such as counting, adding, subtraction, number doubles and pattern making. Enclosed in this pack are activities to use alongside this resources although for more ideas please visit:

- Dice with numbers to use when playing snail race, snail subsidising or roll it, count it, write it games (enclosed).
- Counters: these are helpful in teaching children basic math skills such as counting, sorting and patterning. You could ask your child to count out a certain amount, make a pattern using the colours or add and take away.
- Number fan to promote number recognition
- Number line to 20: Number lines are a great way to accelerate number development. Number lines provide a visual for counting and ordering along with mental strategy for addition and subtraction.

To develop literacy skills –

- Name writing cards for you to practice name recognition and writing.
- Pencil grip guidance to promote appropriate technique.
- Letter formation patter to enable you to practice correct letter using rhymes that are used in school.
- Speed sound cards to inform you on our phonic progression and visuals used.

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
