## A huge thank you to the parents who have embraced our new payment system 'ParentPay'.

The more parents that use ParentPay, the greater the benefit is to our school. There are a few parents who have not accessed their accounts. Activation letters have been sent to those parents. You can help us reduce workloads for all staff, creating more time for educational support and the smooth running of the school. Using ParentPay also ensures that all financial transactions are safe and secure, helping to remove costs associated with us having to manage cash securely on the school premises. **We aim to become a completely cash free office.** We now have an office iPad so we can help you to set up your account. If you need any help with using ParentPay or have any queries relating to payments, the office staff are more than happy to help you.

**Is your child eligible for Free School Meals?**  
*Your child may be eligible for free school meals if you (or the child themselves in their own right) is in receipt of any of the following benefits.*

- Income Support (IS).
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190.
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC).
- Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support.
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods.

### Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM)

All Key Stage 1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) pupils are entitled to receive a free school meal as part of the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) initiative, regardless of what benefits are being claimed.

If you are in receipt of any of the benefits listed above which would entitle your child to free school

meals, your school could claim Pupil Premium funding to support your child's education, just by you completing an application form. You can apply for free school meals (or Pupil Premium) online at:
