

**COVID-19 related pupil absence** A quick reference guide for parents and staff

What to do if	Action Needed	Return to school
		when
my child has: -a runny nose -sore throat -common head cold	Check your child's temperature, if it is below 38 degrees, <b>they can attend school.</b>	Ensure that your child continues to attend school.
my child has Covid- 19 symptoms. - a new, continuous cough - a high temperature (38°+) - a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)	<ul> <li>Do not come to school</li> <li>Contact school to inform us</li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household</li> <li>Get a test</li> <li>Inform the school immediately about the test result</li> </ul>	the test comes back negative <b>or</b> a period of 10 days has passed since the symptoms started, and the child feels well.
my child tests positive for Covid-19.	<ul> <li>Do not come to school.</li> <li>Contact school to inform us ASAP using the school phone number or <u>hello@bugleschool.org.uk</u></li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household.</li> </ul>	10 days have passed since symptoms began, even if they still have a cough or loss of taste/smell. (These symptoms can last for several weeks.) AND the child feels well.
my child tests negative.	- <b>Contact school to inform us.</b> - Discuss when your child can come back (same day/next day).	the test comes back negative.
someone in my household has Covid symptoms.	<ul> <li>Do not come to school.</li> <li>Contact school to inform us.</li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household.</li> <li>Household member to get a test.</li> <li>Inform school immediately about test result.</li> </ul>	the test comes back negative.
someone in my household tests positive for Covid-19.	<ul> <li>Do not come to school.</li> <li>Contact school to inform us.</li> <li>Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 14 days).</li> <li>Self-isolate the whole household.</li> </ul>	the child has completed 14 days of isolation.
NHS test and trace has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with confirmed Covid-19.	<ul> <li>Do not come to school.</li> <li>Contact school to inform us.</li> <li>Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 14 days).</li> </ul>	the child has completed 14 days of isolation.
NHS test and trace has identified a household member (other than my child) as a close contact of somebody with confirmed Covid-19.	<ul> <li>The household member must self-isolate for 14 days.</li> <li>Child can continue to attend school.</li> </ul>	child can continue to attend school
I am unable to get a test for someone in the household who has symptoms	If you are not able to get a test contact the following email address: <u>d-</u> <u>ccg.cornwalldevon.urgenttesting@nhs.net</u> It should be made clear the test is for a child who is attending school.	Once they have had a negative test or the child has completed 14 days of isolation.
