Dear Parents

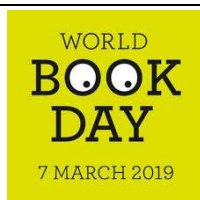

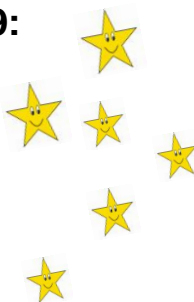

## After School Additional Clubs

The **Go Active After School Club** will be available for KS2 pupils to trial for a 6 week block on Wednesday's after half term up until the Easter holiday. Activities will vary from one week to the next activities such as: street surfing, archery, cross bow, etc will be available to try. We hope to offer this club to pupils KS1 after Easter.

**Boxercise** sessions will take place from Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March for a 5 week block for Year 4 children. These sessions will be delivered by a trained Boxercise coach and will be supervised by a member of school staff. The club will run from 3.15 pm to 4.15 pm and there will be 10 spaces available. The places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Children will need a full change of PE kit to take part in the sessions.

Please note that if you sign up your child to a club, then they should be attending them, unless there is a valid reason for them not to attend. Places for clubs are limited, and there is a waiting list.

## Music Lessons

For a number of weeks, Year 1 have been enjoying music lessons with a difference – we're learning to play the cornet and loving it! Every Tuesday afternoon for the next 5 weeks, the children will be continuing to learn notes and simple tunes on their very own cornet.
