Dear Parents

On Wednesday 3rd July/Wednesday 17th July your child is invited to participate in an outdoor learning experience with Mr.Spriggs and Mrs Sturtridge, to Idless Woods, near Truro. The purpose of the day is to engage in cooperation and problem solving activities in a natural, outdoor setting. The class will be split into two groups, each group having their experience on a different day. For the day your child is not on a trip then it will be a normal school day.

We will be using the school minibus for this trip and hope to leave promptly at 9:05 am. We will begin our return journey with ample time to arrive back before the end of the school day. However, if we are delayed due to traffic, a text message will be sent notifying you of this.

Your child will need a packed lunch as well as a drink (but no fizzy drinks please). It would also be a good idea to have some additional tuck that your child could carry in a pocket for during the morning. A packed lunch can be pre-paid for and ordered from the canteen if you wish (please see Mrs Rowe in the reception area about this). For free school meals, the school will provide a packed lunch.

Clothes suitable for taking part in outdoor tasks, in any weather, will be needed (a coat must be taken). I would advise against shorts due to there being some overgrown footpaths. Clothes worn on this day may well become muddy. Comfortable trainers for walking would be suitable, although if there has been heavy rain you may wish to bring along some wellies.
